Stanadyne Fuel Additive Label Compliance ref ULSD

1. Introduction

Under the US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) regulations, all diesel fuel additives must comply with the labeling requirements found in the Code of Federal Regulations (40 CFR 80.591d) beginning June 1, 2006. This labeling must specify whether the additive complies with the federal ultra low sulfur requirements or not. Stanadyne has previously announced the launching a new line of diesel additives on August 1st 2006, and all labels on these new additives will clearly state that they are within compliance of this ruling.

2. Products Covered

However, please note that all CURRENT Stanadyne additives (i.e. shipped prior to August 1st 2006) also meet the federal requirements by not adding to the sulfur content of less than 15 ppm, and can be used with 2007MY engines.

But in order to comply with EPA requirements, Stanadyne will be adding an extra label on all consumer sizes of our current additives bottles (8 oz, 16 oz and 64 oz). The label reads:

“STANADYNE DIESEL FUEL ADDITIVES COMPLY WITH FEDERAL LOW SULFUR REQUIREMENTS FOR USE IN DIESEL MOTOR VEHICLES AND NONROAD ENGINES.”

These labels will be used on all shipments of additives from the factory, until the new Stanadyne diesel fuel additive product range with the new labeling that already includes the regulatory text is shipped.
